

- ▶ Remember that as a 1099 employee you are able to claim work expenses.
  - Include what is reported on the 1099 you receive. The 1099 we issue includes all of our payments including fee for hours, bonuses, mileage, tolls, parking
  - Calculate the number of business miles incurred and multiply by the amount allowed per mile by the IRS. This rate changes annually and sometimes twice a year
  - Professional liability insurance is deductible. Any other non-health/life insurance can be deducted
  - Fees for business services/advice can be deducted
  - Paper, office supplies, books, GPS, computer supplies used in the performance of the work
  - Clothing used for events
  - Any items purchased in the line of work, blood pressure cuffs etc.
  - Travel that is for business such as CE programs, to clinics
  - Deductions may include: Communications, continuing education, internet, mobile devices, fax equipment, scanning equipment, telephone, any CE courses and training.
